

Processing Update for Blue Cross Blue Shield of New Mexico Medicaid Covered Persons

June 29, 2022

Dear Valued Provider,

Effective June 13th, 2022, Pharmacists with prescriptive authority, who provide extended counseling to Blue Cross Blue Shield of New Mexico (BCBSNM) Medicaid Covered Persons, are able to submit for reimbursement in 15-minute intervals. Reimbursement will also include the cost of the drug, the dispensing fee, and a clinical service payment for prescribing the drug. Documentation of clinical encounters will be required.

This will apply to the following drug classes:

- Hormonal contraception
- Tobacco Cessation
- Immunization
- Naloxone
- HIV PEP Therapy
- TB testing
